Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) are a universal call to act proactively for the well-being of planet earth and its people. Due to that reason, a baseline survey was conducted by National Cleaner Production Center Sri Lanka with the support from the EU SWITCH-Asia Regional Policy Advocacy Component (RPAC)




