"Reviving Uzbekistan's and Tajikistan's sustainable Ikat and Silk RUTSIS"

November 26, 2020 at the Hilton hotel Dushanbe

On November 26, 2020, at the Hilton hotel in Dushanbe, a conference will be held to launch the new project "Reviving Uzbekistan's and Tajikistan's sustainable Ikat and Silk RUTSIS" supported financially by the European Union.

The overall objective of the EU funded SWITCH-Asia programme is to promote sustainable and inclusive growth, contribute to the economic prosperity and poverty reduction in Asia and Central Asia and to a transition towards a low-carbon, resource-efficient and circular economy.

The project is designed for three years and covers a wide range of issues affecting the creation of sustainable production and opportunities for improvement in the ikat and silk value chains. The project activities will focus on:

• Conducting a needs assessment and informing enterprises about possibilities in value chain, taking into account the requirements of sustainable production;

• revitalizing and modernizing local silk and ikat value chains;

• conducting educational trainings and seminars for silk and ikat manufacturers, as well as educational institutions in this field,

- providing advice to specialized educational institutions that train personnel for the silk industry;
- revival of the use of environmentally friendly dyes;

• organization of regional events, cooperation exchanges in the B2B format, fairs and other events with the participation of silk producers

• introducing eco-labeling and ultimately creating opportunities for international recognition of environmentally friendly silk and ikat products from Uzbekistan and Tajikistan.
