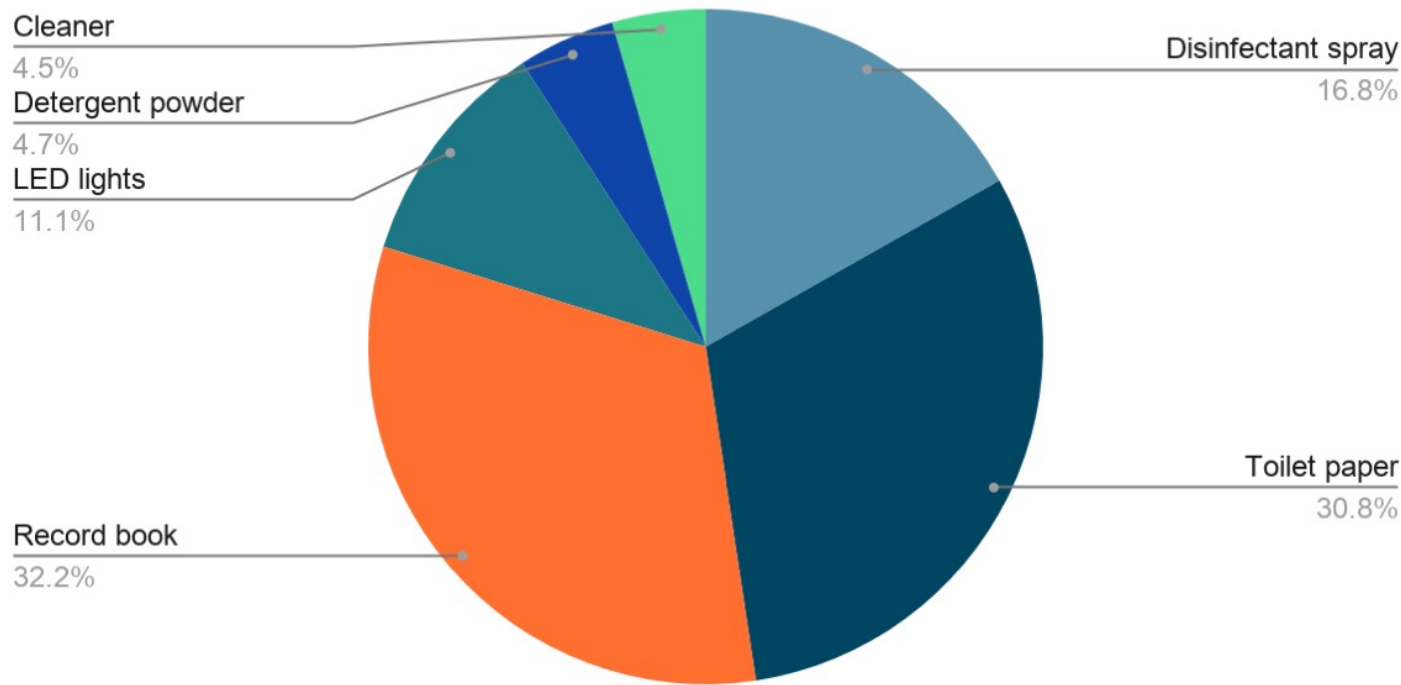

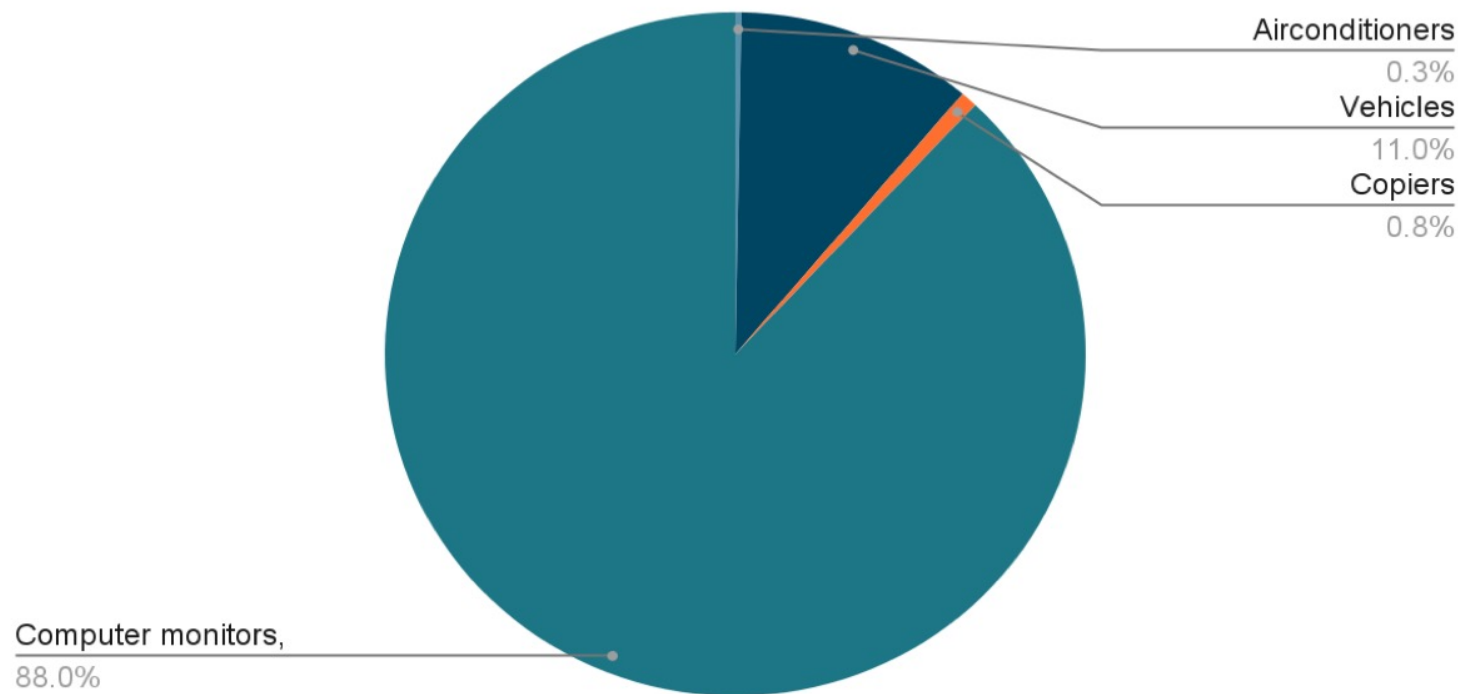
Results (as of December 2020)

Results (as of December 2021)



Trainings related to GPP continued despite the pandemic, delivered through webinars.

A total of **140 GPPB Recognized Trainers** underwent trainings. Meanwhile, **40 Procuring Entities** were given trainings as of December 2021.

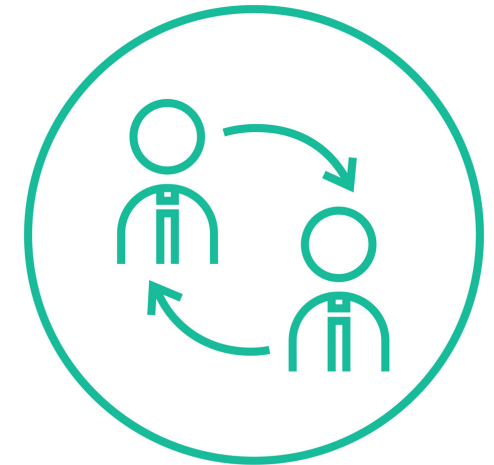

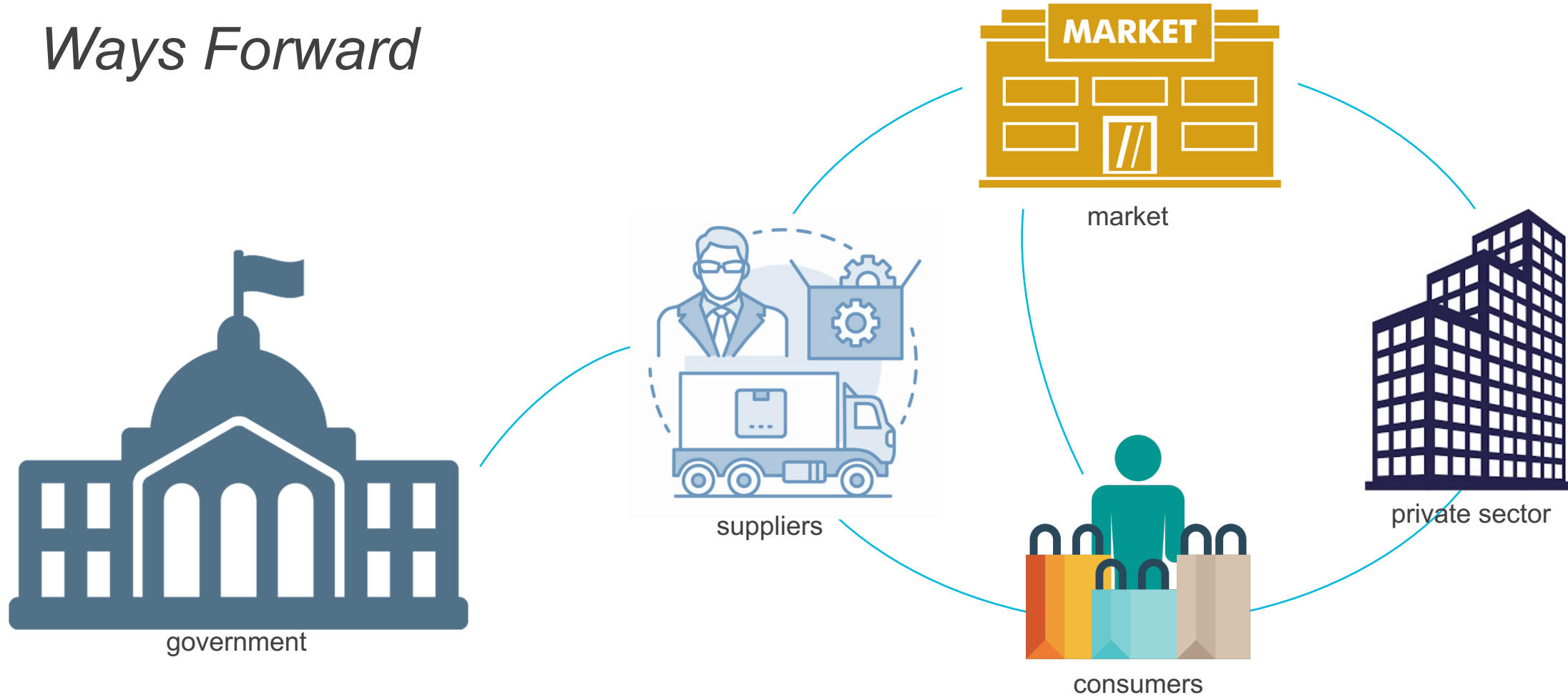
