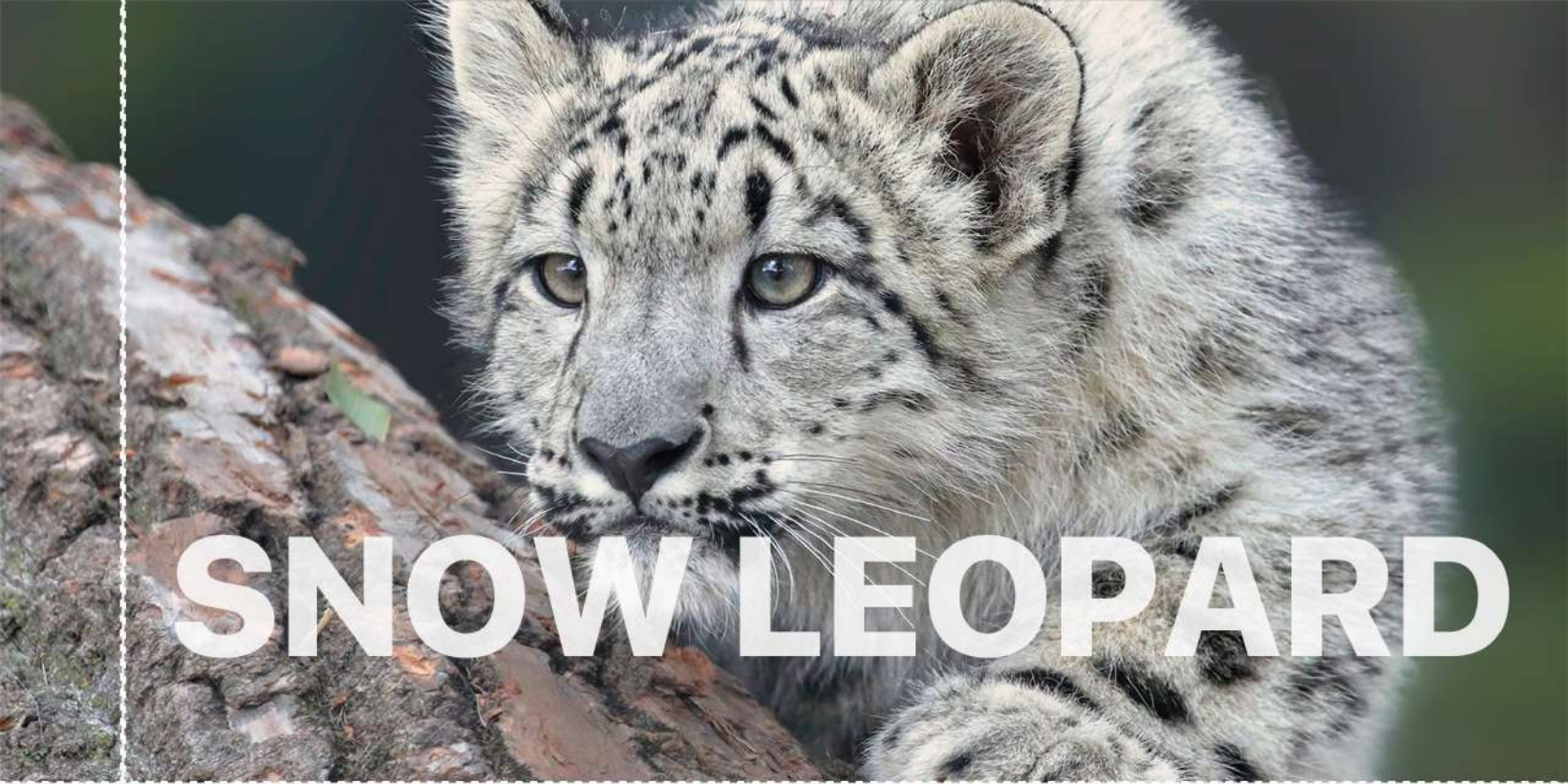
Ak Kalpak

The Ak (white) Kalpak is much more than just a national hat for men - it is a symbol of Kyrgyz culture. Its unique shape and color represent Kyrgyzstan's snow-capped mountains and its four panels symbolize the four cardinal directions and, some say, the four natural elements. The Kalpak's symmetry in form and decoration represents harmony and balance, two values highly esteemed in Kyrgyz culture. Wearing a Kalpak is not only a fashion statement, but an honor and tribute to one's roots and the values of their culture.

Aigul

The Aigul flower is one of the most intriguing mysteries in Kyrgyzstan. Once a year, the Aigul blooms atop the small hill of Aigultash, and it is the only place in the world where this rare and endemic flower grows. Every April, travelers from all over the world journey to Karabulak village in the hope of witnessing this majestic flower.

The Aigul blooms for two weeks after a full moon, and those who are lucky enough to see it are promised eternal happiness according to local legend.

FALCONRY

Snow Leopard

Kyrgyzstan is home to one of the world's most elusive and majestic creatures - the snow leopard. An integral part of the country's history and traditions, this animal symbolizes freedom and independence. Unfortunately, snow leopards are threatened by poaching and habitat destruction. However, Kyrgyzstan is setting an example for conservation efforts, offering hope for the future of the snow leopard.

On October 23, 2013, the Bishkek Declaration on the Conservation of the Snow Leopard was adopted, in which 12 countries committed to ensuring the well-being of snow leopards in healthy ecosystems. Living near snowy peaks, the snow leopard acts as an indicator of the "health" of mountain ecosystems. By protecting these majestic cats, we safeguard the future of Kyrgyzstan's unique culture and environment.

Falconry

Since ancient times, hunting has been a deeply embedded part of Kyrgyz culture and heritage. From hunting with birds of prey and greyhounds (taigans) to training and treating falcons, eagles, and hawks with reverence, the Kyrgyz have long reached a high level of skill in the art of falconry.

In the Kyrgyz national culture, the falcon is more than just a bird of prey - it is a totem and an object of reverence, as evidenced by presence of the white falcon (Ak Shumkar) as the constant companion of the epic hero Manas, and on the National emblem of the Kyrgyz Republic. This reverence for the falcon has been recognized and honored by UNESCO, which included falconry in its list of intangible cultural heritage of mankind.

Issyk-Kul

Issyk-Kul is a breathtakingly beautiful mountain lake, with its crystalline blue and green waters set against a backdrop of majestic mountains, making it a truly one-of-a-kind sight to behold. Translated as "warm lake" from the Kyrgyz language, Issyk-Kul is indeed a remarkable feat, as it never freezes, even at its lofty 1,607 meters above sea level.

Adding to its uniqueness, the lake is fed from 118 rivers and streams, receiving no outflow, leading to its waters having a healing salinity of 0.6%. With its unparalleled beauty and serenity, Issyk-Kul is truly a sight to behold.

Tash Rabat

Tash Rabat is an enchanting, well-preserved caravanserai of the Silk Road, situated in a secluded valley between Mountains. As an important waypoint for traders, it served as a marketplace, educational institution and inn for travelers along the route.

The awe-inspiring beauty of the area is further enhanced by its seclusion, with some of the most spectacular views being from the surrounding hills overlooking the area. For those looking to explore the area further, there are a few hiking trails leading to Chatyr-Kul, an immense lake and nature reserve.

SARY-CHELEK

Manas

The Kyrgyz epic trilogy of Manas, Semetey and Seytek is an important part of Kyrgyz culture and history, passed down from generation to generation by a community of storytellers. Through special forms of narration, rhythm, tone and gestures, the epic is used to teach young people about their heritage, the natural environment and the peoples of the world, reinforcing values of tolerance and multiculturalism.

The Manas Epic has been officially included in the UNESCO List of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity and the Guinness Book of Records as the world's longest epic, with over 5000 lines.

Sary-Chelek

Sary-Chelek is a stunning natural gem nestled in the Western Tian Shan Mountains of Kyrgyzstan. Carved by a landslide around 10,000 years ago, the alpine lake is the largest one within the Sary-Chelek Nature Reserve and is one of seven lakes in the area.

Declared a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve in 1978, the nature reserve is home to rare species of plants, birds, and mammals. For those who love the wilderness, Sary-Chelek is the perfect destination for a multi-day hike or a tour on a horse. The reserve provides stunning views and an opportunity to explore the stunning flora and fauna of the area.

YURT

Shyrdak

Shyrdak is a traditional Kyrgyz thick felt carpet renowned for its intricate mosaic technique, passed down for generations. It can be laid out in a yurt or on the grass, and is typically handmade with bright and contrasting colors.

Symbolic motifs such as the triangle (tumar) and the black and white 'suu' -water border motif are often featured, said to protect from evil. In 2012, the art of making shyrdaks and ala-kiyiz felt carpets was officially recognized by UNESCO and added to the List of Intangible Cultural Heritage.

Yurt

The Kyrgyz Republic is a home to a unique form of portable dwelling. Yurts are circular structures made from a wooden frame and covered in felt or other fabric. These lightweight structures can be set up and taken down quickly, making them ideal for nomadic lifestyles.

Traditional yurts have a white exterior with a red door and a gently sloping roof. Kyrgyz yurts are often adorned with patterns of wood, reeds, or fabric that are passed down for generations. Yurts are a symbol of nomadic life and are deeply embedded in Kyrgyz culture, art, and rituals. In the majestic mountain landscapes of the Kyrgyz Republic, yurts are a reminder of the importance of community and a meaningful connection to nature.



BURANA



SULAIMAN-TOO

Burana

The Burana Tower is a majestic reminder of Kyrgyzstan's rich history, which was built between the 10th and 11th centuries and served as a symbol of the ancient city of Balasagun, constructed by the Karakhanids in the 9th century.

Despite having survived several earthquakes, the tower was in danger of collapsing until it was restored in the 1970s. Today, it is a protected Unesco World Heritage site and a popular attraction in Central Asia, attracting visitors to marvel at its breathtaking beauty.

Sulaiman-Too

Sulaiman-Too Sacred Mountain is a site of immense cultural and spiritual significance. The mountain has five peaks, each with its own petroglyphs and places of worship. Over the centuries, the mountain has been venerated as a sacred site, blending pre-Islamic and Islamic beliefs.

From its peak, Sulaiman Too provides a stunning view of the productive Fergana Valley and the ancient city of Osh, a major crossroads during the Middle Ages. This holy mountain is an example of the cultural and spiritual blending that is so common in Central Asia, and continues to be a beacon for travelers today. Sulaiman-Too was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2009.

Kok-Boru

Kok-Boru is a centuries-old traditional horse game originating from Central Asia, in which two teams on horseback compete to maneuver a goat's carcass, or 'ulak', and score by putting it into the opponents' goal. The game has a rich history and is deeply entwined with the cultural and spiritual identity of its practitioners. The game is thought to have been used to train the men and horses to be fearless and courageous.

Today, the game is mostly performed during festive and social events, and knowledge is primarily passed on through demonstration. In 2017, Kok-Boru was recognised by UNESCO and placed on the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

Nooruz

The Nooruz holiday in Kyrgyzstan marks the coming of spring every year on the day of the Spring Equinox on March 21. This ancient holiday has been passed down through generations and is especially connected with the Zoroastrian religion. An important tradition during this holiday is the gathering around the 'Table' with relatives, adorned with items that symbolize purity, brightness, livelihood, and wealth.

There are also activities such as street performances of music and dance and public rituals involving water and fire, which are aimed to support cultural diversity and tolerance and help build community solidarity and peace. In 2016 the holiday was inscribed on the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.
