The 7th SWITCH-Asia Annual Meeting, scheduled for 27–29 October 2025 in Bangkok, brings together policy makers, businesses, development partners, and civil society to accelerate the transition to circular economies in Asia.

Themed "Scaling Up the Circular Economy in Asia: Bridging Policy, Practice, and Investments through the EU Global Gateway", the event offers a dynamic platform for participants to reflect on the achievements of the EU SWITCH-Asia programme and explore pathways for transforming pioneering initiatives into large-scale investments, thereby accelerating the growth of the circular economy in the region.

By convening government representatives, EU Delegations, experts, and practitioners, the meeting aims to strengthen partnerships that facilitate access to market and investments towards circular value chains within the region and between the EU and Asia.
